Did you know...

If you've traveled with the GO Club since 2009, you may still have a **medical card** you completed. If your meds or conditions change, remember to update your card in pencil. Please keep your card in your

wallet and bring it on all GO Club trips. If you have misplaced your card, or are a new member, please let us know!

Scam Prevention Tips

- Register your telephone number on the National Do Not Call Registry at doNotCall. gov or 888-382-1222 to reduce telemarketing calls.
- Be suspicious of a prize, loan or investment that sounds *too good to be true* and NEVER pay a fee to receive prizes or gifts.
- Consult with someone you trust before making a large purchase or investment and never allow yourself to be pressured or intimidated into immediate decisions.
- Never sign any documents you don't completely understand without first consulting an attorney, trusted family member or close friend.
- Never provide personal information (Social Security number, credit card number, etc.) over the telephone unless you initiated the call and know with whom you're speaking.
- Be suspicious of secretative schemes, or requests to initiate wire transfers or withdraw large amounts of cash no matter what the caller is promising.
